What is your favorite part of the video? Describe it below.



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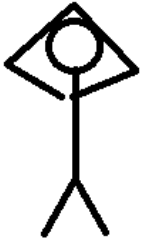
All animals including humans need food, water, shelter and space to survive. Below draw your favorite animal with all four components.

Shelter: Hold your hands above your head.



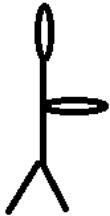
Food: Use your hands to pretend that you are eating.
